Officials Investigate Breach of Laws on Bimini

Preliminary reports coming out of Bimini, are that officers from the Royal Bahamas Police Force and Bahamas Department of Immigration are questioning a group of individuals inclusive of one (1) foreign adult male, for breach of several laws.

Officials from both Agencies in New Providence are en route to the island, as local law enforcement officers are currently being assisted by two (2) foreign nationals.

We remain at the preliminary stages of this investigation; hence, an official press release is forthcoming as the facts of evidence become known.

The public is reminded that the Department is committed to executing the mandates of our agency by effectively coordinating efforts with other Law Enforcement agencies to ensure compliance with the Statute Laws of our Country.
