21 CUBAN MIGRANTS REPATRIATED

Today, at approximately 2:29PM (18) eighteen Males and (3) three Females were repatriated from New Providence to Havana, Cuba. This group was escorted by a joint law enforcement team, comprising of Officers of the Royal Bahamas Defence Force and the Immigration Department.

This escort was led by Vonnetta Darling-Flowers, Senior Immigration Officer onboard a Bahamasair charter flight, with all Ministry of Health COVID-19 protocols strictly enforced. The health, welfare and safety of our officers, law enforcement counterparts, and migrants remain the highest priority in this COVID-19 environment. The Department of Immigration extends special thanks to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Health, and the Cuban Embassy for their usual and full cooperation.

The public is reminded that the Department is committed to executing the mandates of our agency by effectively coordinating efforts with other Law Enforcement agencies, and international stakeholders to ensure compliance with the Statute Laws of our country.
