64 HAITIAN NATIONALS REPATRIATED TO HAITI FROM NEW PROVIDENCE

Today at approximately 1:20PM, the Department of Immigration working in accordance with UNHCR guidelines, repatriated forty-six (46) Males, thirteen (13) adult Females, and five (5) minors from Lynden Pindling International Airport to the Port-au-Prince, Haiti onboard a Bahamasair flight.

This group was escorted by a joint team of Royal Bahamas Defence Force and Immigration officers, along with officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. All Ministry of Health Coronavirus safety protocols were strictly enforced, as safety remain our main focus in this climate.

The public is reminded that we are committed to executing the mandates of our agency by effectively coordinating efforts with other Law Enforcement agencies, and international stakeholders to ensure compliance with the Statute Laws of The Bahamas.
