260 HAITIAN NATIONALS REPATRIATED TO CAP-HAITIEN, HAITI

On Wednesday, October 6, at 9:00AM a Bahamasair charter flight departed Matthew Town, Inagua bound for Cap-Haitien, Haiti with one hundred twenty (120) females, nine (9) males, and three (3) minors onboard. An additional repatriation flight later departed Matthew Town at approximately 11:39AM also en route to Cap-Haitien, with a group of one hundred ten (110) males and eighteen (18) females.

Repatriations are set to continue this week.

On Monday, October 4, three hundred sixty-eight (368) Haitian nationals appeared before Chief Magistrate Joyann Ferguson-Pratt and Magistrate Shaka Serville and pled guilty to the charge of Illegal Landing. Subsequently, they were conditionally discharged and deportation was recommended.

The Department of Immigration is committed to carrying out the mandates of our agency to combat illegal migration by establishing effective border control management to ensure compliance with the Statute Laws of our country.
