145 FOREIGNNATIONALS REPATRIATED FROM NEW PROVIDENCE

On today's date, at approximately 11:43am, a Bahamasair chartered flight departed New Providence en route to Havana, Cuba with fourteen (14) Cuban nationals onboard; eleven (11) males and three (3) females.

Additionally, a group of one hundred thirty (130) Haitian nationals departed New Providence for Port-au-Prince, Haiti at approximately 1:30pm, onboard a Bahamasair chartered flight. This group consisted of one hundred seven (107) males, twelve (12) females, and eleven (11) minors.

One Jamaican male was also repatriated to Kingston, Jamaica onboard Caribbean Airlines at 2:30pm.

The Department's Deportation Unit led all escorts with Department mandated COVID-19 protocols strictly observed as the health, welfare, and safety of our officers, law enforcement counterparts, and migrants remain the highest priority.
