## 46 Migrants Apprehended at Sea by United States Coast Guard

On Friday, 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, officers from the Enforcement Unit, Grand Bahama District received a group of forty-six (**46**) migrants found in waters near Anguilla Cay from the United States Coast Guard (USCG) Cutter Paul Clark.

The group consisted of thirty-one (31) Cuban nationals, twenty-one (21) adult males, six (6) adult females and four (4) minors; four (4) Jamaican nationals, two (2) adult males, and two (2) adult females; seven(7) Haitian nationals, three (3) adult males and four (4) adult females; three (3) Chinese adult males; and one (1) Brazilian adult female.

In keeping with the Department and the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 guidelines, all migrants were examined, tested and subsequently transported to the Carmichael Road Detention Center on Friday for further processing and to await repatriation to their homeland; all safety protocols were strictly observed during transport and handover.
