217 Haitian Migrants Apprehended at Sea

On Wednesday, 16th November, 2022 a group of two hundred and seventeen (217) Haitian migrants were intercepted by United States Coast Guard (USCG) Cutter "William Flores and "Escanaba" six (6) nautical miles off Dog Rock near Cay Sal Bank.

The group was subsequently transported to the capital on Saturday, 19th November, 2022 where they received medical screening and turned over to Immigration Officials for further processing.

Presently, arrangements are being coordinated for the deportation of all irregular migrants. Preparations have also been made to utilize facilities at Matthew Town, Inagua in the event of an increase in migrant interceptions.

The Department reassures the public of our commitment to regulating the movement of people throughout The Bahamas so as to ensure the safety of its citizenry.
