122 HAITIAN NATIONALS AND 41 CUBAN NATIONALS REPARTRIATED FROM NEW PROVEIDENCE

On Friday, 13th January, 2023 the Department effectively executed two (2) repatriation exercises; a total of one hundred sixty-three (163) persons lawfully removed from the country.

Firstly, at approximately 7:52 a.m., a Bahamasair chartered flight departed New Providence for Port-Au-Prince, Haiti with one hundred twenty-two (122) Haitian nationals onboard; ninety-four (94) males, twenty-seven (27) females and one (1) minor.

Additionally, at 12:15 p.m., a Bahamasair flight departed New Providence for Havana, Cuba with forty-one (41) Cuban nationals onboard; thirty-seven (37) males and four (4) females.

The Departments Deportation and Enforcement Units led the escort and all health and security protocols were observed as the welfare and safety of our officers and migrants remain the highest priority.
